Those attending the show will be able to follow the jury's commentary in the English lanquage via a headset. Seize this chance to learn even more about the Friesian horse! We have a limited number of headsets, so if you haven't reserved a headset, come to the Guest-desk early in the morning! A headset costs € 10,- day, and 3 days for € 25,-. This amount must be paid in cash at the KFPS Guest-desk in Leeuwarden. When you pick up a headset at the Guestdesk you will be asked to also pay a deposit of \in 35,- per headset. After returning the headsets your deposit will be refunded. We do ask you to return the headset every day because the headsets need to be recharged at night.

Appearing in the inspection ring will be the latest crop of stallions as well as the older stallions. Big names and former Stallion Inspection champions that can always count on a warm reception from the audience. This year, there will be some changes in the championship judging. Instead of a single champion being crowned, there will also be a young champion, a champion chosen from among the older stallions and the grand champion who will take the A.K.W. Douma Cup home. In 2011, Uldrik 457 extended his title as champion. Which stallion will leave with such an honor this year? The stallion inspection on the 14th of January 2012 can be followed live all over the world at Omrop Fryslân (the regional broadcasting company). From 10:00 hrs.
